

Definition of Boxes of Bird strike Occurrence Reporting Form SRF -106

Complete ALL boxes. If Not Applicable use N/A or if Not Known use N/K. Avoid use of technical jargon, hieroglyphics and abbreviations. It is important that this form is completed in as much detail as possible

Headline	A short message identifying the occurrence to the human reader
Local Date	Insert Local Date of occurrence (dd/mm/yyyy) example: 12/12/12
Local Time	The Local time of the occurrence entered using the 24 hour clock e.g. 23:59
Aerodrome Location Indicator	Aerodrome Location indicator. A four-letter code group formulated in accordance with rules prescribed by ICAO and assigned to the location of an aeronautical fixed station. Example for Kutaisi International Airport: UGKO
Runway used	The runway identifier e.g. (31L, 13R)
Flight phase	The phase of flight in which the event occurred
Aircraft parts	The parts of the aircraft struck or damaged by the bird strike The parts of the aircraft struck or damaged by the bird strike.
Operator	A person, Organization or Enterprise, engaged in or offering to engage in an Aircraft Operation e.g. (Lufthansa, Cargo lux)
Operation Type	The type of operation indicates whether this was a public transport operation (airline operation) or a general aviation flight. Details see in description
Aircraft Registration	The mark used to identify an aircraft. The mark consists of a common mark or nationality mark followed by a registration mark e.g. (4L-XXX,)
Aircraft Engine make/model	Manufacturer/Model of engine involved e.g. (BMW, BOMBARDER)
Aircraft Type	The ICAO aircraft type designator - four character code assigned to the aircraft - is defined as an alias. [ICAO Doc 8643] (example B735)
Location if en route	Specify portion of the route where occurrence took place
Height AGL	Altitude of aircraft put in boxes instead of flight level letters – (FL) and instead of Altitude letter- (A) and then figures (example FL340,A7500)
Speed (IAS)	The aircraft speed at the first event.
Effect on Flight	An event evolving from bird strike event.
Sky condition	Sky cover classification for aviation weather observations and precipitation e.g. (overcast, fog, rain)
Precipitation	The type of precipitation. ICAO Annex 3
Bird species	Generally the species of birds that were involved in the occurrence e.g. (swallow, dove, eagle)
Number of birds	Amount of birds totally seen or struck during occurrence
Size of bird	The estimated size of bird
Pilot warned of birds	Pilot advised of the presence of birds
Narrative	A short narrative describing the occurrence. Use standardized abbreviations only. Where practicable do not repeat information entered in the coded data. Include all information which is required to convey the scenario of the occurrence to the reader. In particular highlight that information that cannot be included in the coded data
